ITINERARY

MONDAY, JULY 15

Have an easy travel day aboard your comfortable motorcoach. This afternoon, we'll visit the 9/11–Flight 93 National Memorial. This touching shrine is dedicated to the heroic flight crew and passengers aboard Flight 93 on that fateful day. You'll see the new Visitors Center Complex and view the Flight Path Overlook. Later, we'll check into the Hampton Inn in Bedford, PA.

TUESDAY, JULY 16

This morning, a short drive will bring us to Lancaster, PA and The Amish Village. Originally, the village was an Amish homestead, but now offers visitors an excellent example of Amish culture. Start with a guided tour of the house, followed by self-guided tours of the grounds, which include the barn and blacksmith workshop. You'll also have a chance to converse with the Amish workers. A fantastic buffet luncheon is included at Fisher's Amish Restaurant. This afternoon, we'll take a guided tour of the countryside, where you'll see beautifully maintained Amish farms and homes. Later, we'll tour the amazing Spooky Nook Sports complex in Manheim, PA. It's a great example of the Spooky Nook complex coming soon to Hamilton, OH. This fantastic family-oriented sports, entertainment, and event venue is the largest complex of its kind in the U.S. Dinner is on your own at Spooky Nook's Forklift & Palate Restaurant, where some of the best farm to table American cuisine in the state is served. We will overnight at the Comfort Inn in Lancaster for the next two nights. (B, L)

WEDNESDAY, JULY 17

In Hershey, PA, see the famous street lights shaped like candy kisses, before we stop at Chocolate World. On our fun-filled Trolley Tour, you'll learn how Milton Hershey built his candy factory, the town, and his wonderful Hershey School for disadvantaged youth. This afternoon, you'll experience a very special and inspirational performance of Jesus at Sight & Sound Theatre. On the huge 300° wrap-around stage, you'll see dozens of actors, along with both live and automated animals. Colorful costumes and intricately detailed sets are also part of the performance. It is a delight to the senses! Jesus' story may be familiar, but His actions still surprise us. From the streets of Jerusalem to the raging Sea of Galilee, Jesus befriends outcasts and heals the hurting. He challenges social norms and confronts hypocrisy. He sets sail with fishermen and reasons with religious scholars. The lives He touches will never be the same. No place—and no person—is beyond the reach of His Love. Tonight, you'll dine at Lancaster County's favorite restaurant–Shady Maple Smorgasbord. We'll feast on deliciously authentic Pennsylvania Dutch cooking. (B, D)
