



ITINERARY

THURSDAY, AUGUST 1

Depart from your home city for Amsterdam, Netherlands.

FRIDAY, AUGUST 2 | Amsterdam

Arrive in Amsterdam. Check into our hotel. Meet our cruise director at a reception. The remainder of the evening will be at your at leisure.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 3 | Amsterdam

An included city tour of Amsterdam will provide the perfect overview, before enjoying leisure time on your own. (B)

SUNDAY, AUGUST 4 | Embarkation

Check out of our hotel and, before transferring to the ship, we will visit Zaanse Schanse windmills and village. A Welcome cocktail reception on board will be followed by dinner and an opportunity to meet the crew. (B, D)

MONDAY, AUGUST 5 | Amsterdam

The famous canals of Amsterdam await your discovery, on our scenic canal cruise. Tall, narrow homes along the water, the beautiful wooden Skinny Bridge, and the Anne Frank House are a few of the highlights we will see. Later in the day, after returning to our ship, we'll set sail out of Amsterdam. (B, L, D)

TUESDAY, AUGUST 6 | Cologne, Germany

Enjoy cruising to Cologne, home to one of Germany's most revered Gothic masterpieces, the Cologne Cathedral. Join a tour through the Old Town, visiting the cathedral and Germany's oldest town hall, the Rathaus. Visit a local tavern to sample its famous Kolsch beer and Reibekuchen, potato pancakes served with applesauce. A guided bike tour along the Rhine will also be offered. (B, L, D)

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 7 | Rhine Gorge-Rudesheim

Today, we'll cruise through the magnificent Rhine Gorge, the most scenic stretch of the Rhine River. Steep vineyards and hilltops with a variety of castles enhance the scenery. We will take a gondola ride up to the Niederwalddenkmal Statue. Afterward, we'll be treated to wine tasting. Arrive at the winemaking town of Rudesheim. Here, optional hiking or bike tours will be available. We will visit Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum, with its remarkable collection of self-playing musical instruments, or taste one of the town's special delights, Rudesheimer Coffee, made with brandy, coffee, and whipped cream. THURSDAY, AUGUST 8 | Ludwigshafen

Today, choose from three different excursions. You can visit Heidelberg, the perfectly preserved medieval city on the Neckar River Valley along Germany's Castle Road. Discover the iconic Heidelberg Castle and Great Vat, an 18th-century 49,000-gallon wine cask. A hike up the Philosopher's Walk in Heidelberg will be another option, or you can visit one of Germany's oldest cities, Speyer, known for the largest Romanesque cathedral in Europe and the medieval Altpotel, Old Gate. (B, L, D)

FRIDAY, AUGUST 9 | Strasbourg, France

Strasbourg is the capital city of Alsace and, because of its borderline location, offers flavors of both France and Germany. Enjoy a panoramic tour past the stunning Parc de l'Orangerie, the European Parliament, and the Place de la Republique, before walking through its iconic "La Petite France" district. Wander through these charming streets and past the Cathedrale de Notre Dame, with its famous astronomical clock. A bike tour through the city will also be offered. (B, L, D)

SATURDAY, AUGUST 10 | Breisach, Germany

Several tours will be offered today. Step back in time in the enchanting Alsatian town of Riquewihr, which looks almost the same as it did in the 16th century. Admire the architecture and the Dolder Gate. Or, you may wish to go to Freiburg, founded in 1120 and home to the Freiburg Minster, a Gothic cathedral said to have "the most beautiful spire on earth." A bike tour through the scenic countryside will also be available, as well as an excursion to the Black Forest lots of interesting choices. (B, L, D)

SUNDAY, AUGUST 11 | Basel, Switzerland

This morning, we say goodbye to the ship's crew, and continue our journey in Switzerland, with our friend and special guide, Rolf Stauber, who has been associated with our trips to beautiful Switzerland for over 25 years. We will head to Zurich, and our home for the next two nights, the Marriott Zurich Hotel. We will see many of the sites of Zurich and the surrounding area, including the Old Town, lake area, FIFA Headquarters, and more. Dinner will be at the Die Waid Restaurant, with a panoramic view overlooking Zurich. (B, D)

MONDAY, AUGUST 12 | Zurich-Lucerne

Early this afternoon, we will depart for Lucerne—the country's most popular city—in the heart of Central Switzerland. We will travel to Vitznau, where we will board a lake steamer for a beautiful scenic cruise on Lake Lucerne. On our arrival in Lucerne, we will take a walking tour, including a crossing on the famous covered bridge. Time will be allowed for shopping, before going to the fantastic Old Swiss House restaurant, known for its extraordinary schnitzel. After dinner, we'll return to Zurich. (B, D)

TUESDAY, AUGUST 13

After breakfast, we'll say farewell to Switzerland, and transfer to the airport for our return home, bringing back wonderful memories of this exciting 12-day trip. (B)
