ITINERARY

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5

Depart Cincinnati early this morning for Batavia, NY, with stops made en route. Lunch and dinner today will be included. Overnight in Batavia at the Quality Inn Hotel. (L, D)

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6

Enjoy an included breakfast. Each morning, we will rotate seats on the motorcoach. Arrive in Stockbridge in the mid-afternoon. Visit the Norman Rockwell Museum and see many of the illustrator's original oil paintings. Check in to the Jiminy Peak Resort in Hancock, MA. Enjoy an included dinner, before retiring for the evening. (B, D)

MONDAY, OCTOBER 7

Following breakfast, take a driving tour of Berkshire Cottages. Known as the "Inland Newport," these "cottages" were the homes of some of the most famous of the American Aristocracy. Next, visit Tanglewood, home of the Boston Symphony and Boston Pops. Stop early this afternoon at Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market for lunch on your own. The afternoon includes a Boston City tour, visiting the Old North Church, Boston Common, and other sights. Dine this evening at the Chateau Restaurant in Andover, MA. Overnight at the Spring Hill Suites in Andover. (B, D)

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8

This morning, stop at Stonewall Kitchen to sample some of Maine's finest jams and jellies. After, travel to Nubble Light, one of Maine's most photographed lighthouses. Next, visit the Seashore Trolley Museum, then take a scenic ride on a restored streetcar through the countryside, enjoying the fall foliage. We will stop for lunch and shopping in Kennebunkport, then take a narrated driving tour of the area. Tonight, enjoy a classic lobster dinner (or steak) at Jonathan's Restaurant. Overnight at Meadowmere Resort in Ogunquit, ME. (CB, D)

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 9

Following breakfast, we'll drive to North Conway, NH, where you will have time for shopping and lunch on your own. After lunch, we'll take a drive along the Kancamagus Highway, one of the most scenic routes in America, winding through the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Stops include the Albany covered bridge, Rocky Gorge, and the Sugar Hill overlook. We'll also stop at the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway, with spectacular views of the White Mountains. Accommodations for the next two nights will be the Mountain Club Resort in Lincoln, NH. Tonight, we'll dine at our hotel. (CB, D)

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10

After breakfast, we'll travel take a scenic drive to Weirs Beach. We'll board the M/S Mount Washington, and cruise across Lake Winnipesaukee to Wolfeboro, the oldest summer resort in America. Enjoy time for shopping and lunch on your own. This afternoon, we'll visit the Wright Museum, featuring World War II exhibits, as well as exhibits of daily life from that era. We'll dine this evening on the Café Lafayette dinner train. (B, D)

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 11

After breakfast, travel to Quechee Gorge, Vermont's little grand canyon, a short walk from the Vermont Tourist Center. Next, we'll go to Sugarbush Farm, where you will enjoy a maple syrup making demonstration and cheese samples. Eat lunch on your

own in Woodstock, and enjoy free time. This afternoon, we'll stop at the Vermont Country Store, as we begin our journey back to Cincinnati. Overnight at the Albany, NY Fairfield Inn. Dinner this evening will be included. (B, D)

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12

Following breakfast, we'll continue home along the Southern Tier Route, a highway through scenic parts of New York. We'll make stops en route, including a stop for lunch on your own. Overnight at the Comfort Inn in Jamestown, NY. Dinner this evening will be included. (CB, D)

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13

Following breakfast, we'll continue our trip home. We'll make stops en route, including a stop for lunch on your own. We'll return to Cincinnati in the late afternoon. **(CB)**
