## **ITINERARY**

**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 22:** As we travel south aboard our comfortable motorcoach, we will stop in Nashville for a delicious southern buffet luncheon. We will arrive in Memphis by late afternoon and check in to the Hampton Inn Beale Street. The remainder of the day and evening is yours to enjoy the many fine restaurants and entertainment venues that Beale Street has to offer. This is Memphis at its best! (L)

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23: After your included continental breakfast at the hotel, we'll board the City of New Orleans Superliner for a fun day of rail travel. You'll have a comfortable, reserved coach seat and be able to enjoy the views from large windows. The train offers a unique dining experience in the Cross Country Café, where you'll find a wide variety of delicious regional cuisine, with vegetarian options, to satisfy your tastes, as you "ride the rails." Today, we'll travel through the heart of "Dixie" and experience unique and charming southern sights and scenery. By late afternoon, we'll arrive in the Crescent City of New Orleans, to board a deluxe motorcoach that will provide our transportation for the remainder of the trip. We will check in to the La Quinta Inn Downtown for three nights. Your hotel is just two blocks from the famous French Quarter, where we will enjoy a fine dinner this evening. You'll have several choices of New Orleans-style cuisine. Later, you may wish to stroll the French Quarter and hear the great music for which it is known. (CB, D)

**TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24:** With a local guide, we'll tour the city and see Jackson Square, St. Louis Cathedral, and the Garden District. We'll travel along the Mardi Gras parade route and learn about the city's famous carnival. You'll see lovely old buildings with beautiful iron lattice work, and hear about the Creole and Cajun culture, and the city's rich musical heritage. On our fascinating Swamp Boat Tour, you'll cruise along the most pristine swamplands in the U.S. Alligators and wild boars are most often seen, and there have been sightings of owls, bald eagles, and black bears. The guides are experts at finding the animals and explaining the ecosystem, legends, and mysteries. We may even see the Honey Island Swamp Monster! (B)

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 25: A full morning visit to the National World War II Museum is awe inspiring! The museum chronicles the war years and documents the heroic acts of our brave men and women. The theater is a wonderful, historical cinematic experience, narrated by Tom Hanks. Exhibits include the invasion of Normandy and the war in the Pacific. A highlight is our buffet luncheon, followed by a USO-style show in the museum's BB's Stage Door Canteen! This afternoon, we will visit Houmas House Mansion. The grand antebellum home is called the "Crown Jewel of Louisiana's River Road." The mansion has been lovingly restored, and the 38 acres of gardens, fountains, and live oak trees are magnificent!
