ITINERARY

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 15:

This morning, we will fly from Cincinnati to Palm Springs, CA. Our late morning arrival gives us plenty of time to become familiar with our new surroundings. The Palm Mountain Resort & Spa offers a Day Spa, a beautiful, heated outdoor pool, new hot tub, and fire pits for cozy evenings by the pool. It's just a short stroll to the Desert Art Museum, 40+ popular restaurants, unique shops, boutiques, galleries, and the Spa Casino. Numerous entertainment venues are in the area, featuring music, dancing, comedy, and more! Tonight, a "Welcome to Palm Springs Dinner" is included. (D)

SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 16:

After our included breakfast, we'll tour the Coachella Valley with our local guide. You'll see the "Old Movie Colony," the former homes of such legends as Bob Hope, Frank Sinatra, Marilyn Monroe, Elvis, and Liberace. The legendary "Two Hour Rule" of Hollywood studios put Palm Springs on the map as a perfect getaway. Actors under contract had to be available within two hours from the studio, just in case last-minute film/photo shoots occurred. We'll also travel through some of the other well-known cities in the valley: Rancho Mirage, Palm Desert, and Indian Wells. You'll learn about the area's history from the early Native Americans to their influence even today. We'll see the area's most important agriculture crop, with a visit to a date farm. (B)

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17:

This morning, breakfast is included. Then, the day is yours to do as you please. It's Presidents' Day, so there are sure to be lots of activities on Palm Canyon Drive. This evening, we include gift cards for your dinner. Eat where, when, and what you want! (B, D)

TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 18:

Today, we will take the amazing Palm Springs Aerial Tramway. You'll travel from the valley floor to near the top of San Jacinto Peak—two-and-a-half miles. During the journey, your tram car slowly rotates, offering picturesque and spectacular vistas of the valley below. Once you reach Mountain Station—elevation 8,516'—enjoy restaurants, the observation deck, natural history museum, theaters, and gift shop. Dress warmly; it's chilly at the top (although attractions are indoors). (B)

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 19:

Today, our local guide joins us again for a tour to Joshua Tree National Park. The park is named after the Joshua trees that grow abundantly here. Pinon pine, California juniper, Yucca, and Cholla cactus, as well as Fan Palms (the only native palm tree in California) are also found in the park. The park encompasses almost 800,000 acres and portions of two deserts—the Mojave and Colorado. They each have their own unique ecosystem determined by elevation: the higher Mojave Desert and the lower Colorado Desert. Unique rock formations are found throughout the park and make this area seem otherworldly. Our guide will help us understand how Mother Nature formed this fascinating area. Today, a sumptuous luncheon buffet is included. Our drive offers the interesting scenery in south central California. (B, L)

THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 20:

After an included breakfast, we will head to the airport for our flight home. We will return with memories of a terrific Palm Springs Vacation! (B)
